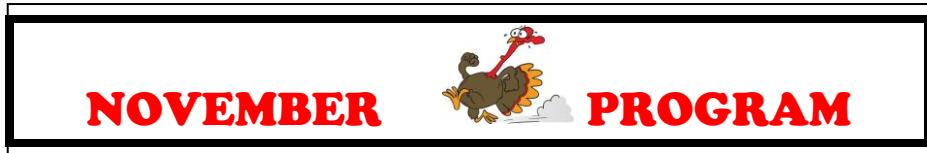

Make sure your online experience is a safe one.

When using the internet or social media it is important to:

Avoid sharing seemingly common personal information. Users with malicious intent can collect data from you and use it to create fake profiles. Only share personal information on trusted websites and with people you trust.

When you click on a link, ensure that you are going where you intend to by carefully reading the website url.

Never click on suspicious popups or open any attachments in emails from strangers. Do not click on links you do not trust.

Be wary of pop-up which display unusual security warnings, asking you to download programs such as antivirus software, or request personal information when you have done nothing to prompt such action.

Malware and viruses spread easily because of negligence. Be aware of what you plug into your computer and other devices because infected flash drives, external hard drives and even smart phones can be used to transmit viruses. Never plug anything into your device you have not purchased yourself.

Use strong passwords that have a combination of at least eight letters, numbers



and punctuation marks. Avoid commonly used words or easy to remember passwords.

How do I ensure that my computer, devices, and accounts are protected from malicious users

If you use a public computer, make sure that you log out of your accounts when are done.

Make sure you update your software programs and apps from official sources to keep your security up to date.

Occasionally clear your browser history and cookies through your browser settings.

Remember! If something seems too good to be true, it probably is. If a link or email seems suspicious to you, do not open it under any circumstances.

Secure your home WiFi with strong and unique passwords so no one else can use it to snoop on your transmissions.

Securing your mobile phone



Lock your mobile phone with a passcode only you know.

Enable remote wipe (erasure of all your stored cellphone data) and location features to protect your privacy in case you devices is lost or stole

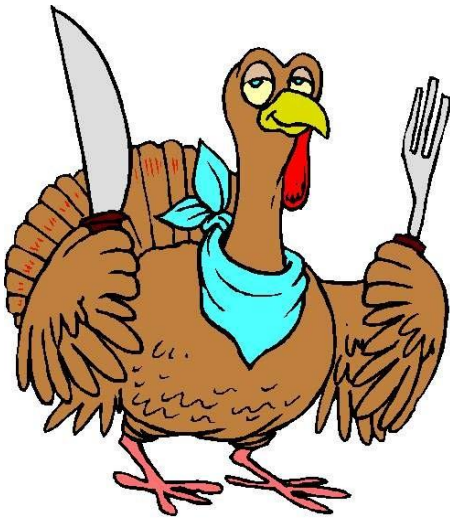

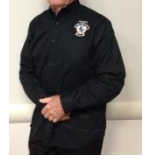

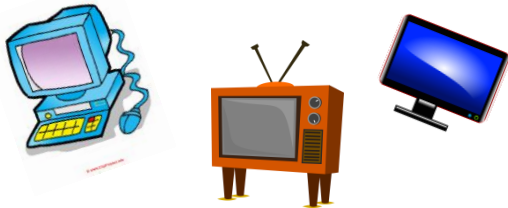

COMPUTER ROUNDUP



Arlington will hold its computer roundup on Saturday, November 12th at the UTA parking lot on the corner of Cooper and Mitchell from 8am – 12 noon.

Here is your chance to recycle any electronic equipment that you want to clear out of your garage. Bring it with you and proof of residence - Your water bill is your ticket to a clean garage.

Some Driving Safety Tips

Use your turn signals when making any change of direction. Use them when making any turn, even in a turn lane and when making a U-turn. The vehicles behind you will appreciate knowing what you are planning to do.

A STOP Sign means S-T-O-P! It does not mean slow down and roll through the intersection.

Check your lights to make sure they are working. There are 3 elements in your tail lights. One for the brakes, one for your lights, and one for your turn signals. Have someone stand safely behind your vehicle and check to see if they are all working once a month. If any one of the elements is not working, replace the bulb.

You can check the lights in the front by checking them by shining the lights against a wall or your garage door.

If you have a blue handicap mirror hanger, remove it when the vehicle is in motion. It blocks your vision when hanging on your mirror.
