ACPAAA Membership Meeting Minutes
November 9, 2017

Jim Colley introduced Officer Detective Justin Trzepacz talking on Identity Theft and Fraud. Detective are very busy with 215 reports for 3 detectives. Fraud hit 10% of the population in 2011. Much higher now. Five types of internet fraud: lottery, emergency, romance, overpayment and property. A very interesting program with questions and stories from the membership at the end.

He stated a security freeze on credit reports should be considered plus deleting the location settings on your phone and internet tools.

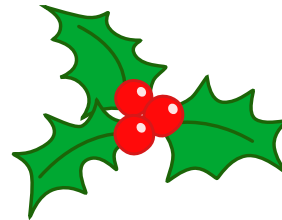
